

The Jasper County Commission general session was held on Tuesday, August 30, 2016 at the Jasper County Courthouse. The meeting was opened at 9:00 a.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance and prayer by Keith Stammer.

Roll call:

John Bartosh and Darieus Adams are present. Jim Honey is absent.

Approval of minutes:

Commissioner Adams made the motion to approve the minutes of August 23, 2016. Commissioner Bartosh seconded. Minutes are approved.

New Business:

Emergency repairs were made to the kitchen air conditioning and heating unit at the jail.

The companies that bid on the project were: Satterlee Plumbing Heating and Air Conditioning: option 1- \$13,250.00 and option 2-\$13,895.00, Simpson Sheet Metal - \$13,150.00 and Johnson Control was \$24,000.00. Sheriff Kaiser requested the bid go to Satterlee Plumbing. The bid was a little higher but the warranty is more inclusive and longer. The emergency decision was made to go with Satterlee Plumbing, option 2, for \$13,895.00.

Public Hearing:

The first of three hearings was opened to discuss placement of 45 mile an hour speed limit signs on Maverick Road and Hawthorne Road between Highway 43 and Highway 171. There was no discussion and the public hearing was closed.

With no further business the meeting was adjourned.
